Thank you for your submittal of the Request for a Waiver from the Assessment Program, Part V.B.1. of your MS4 permit. The Town's waiver request is approved.

Your report concludes that the Town of South Palm Beach MS4 consists of the City Hall stormwater system and is a de minimis contribution to the Lake Worth Lagoon, which is not impaired. Based on this information, the Town is exempted from addressing Assessment Program Part V.B.1 of the permit. The permit may be reopened and revised during the life of the permit to address changes in State or Federal statutory or regulatory requirements.

Dear Ms. Bull,

The Town of South Palm Beach is a co-permittee in Palm Beach County's NPDES permit as cited above. The Town's NPDES contributing area is limited to an 0.88-acre lot owned by the Town that has one municipal building. The land use is institutional with a municipal center, police department, and 22 parking spaces with connecting driveways. Relative to its stormwater system; there is one storm inlet with a direct outfall into the Intracoastal Waterway. As the municipal offices are on this site which includes the police department, there is little generation of or contributions to pollutant loadings into the Lake Worth Lagoon. As the Town's contributions to pollutant loadings are de minimis (due to size and minimal contributions) we hereby request a waiver to the Water Quality Assessment Plan requirements in PBC NPDES Permit No. FLS00018, Part V, sub-part B monitoring requirement.
