The following is being provided on behalf of the Town of Lake Clarke Shores in response to your email request of May 23, 2018 for additional clarification of the original responses.

Original Q 4: Are these contractors, or Town staff with FDACS licenses?

Original A 4: The five individuals listed as applicators of fertilizer are Town staff. Since there is no section to list Personnel who are fertilizer applicators, this data shall be removed from the report. Q 4 Clarification Request: Staff that apply fertilizer are required to have the Green Industries BMP. Do the three staff reported as FDACS licensed applicators of fertilizer have the Green Industries BMP training?

Q 4 Clarification Response: Yes.

Original Q 5: Describe the one inspection reported. SOP states commercial areas and drive-by inspections are performed.

Original A 5: The Town has a proactive inspection program that covers the entire system once per year. The actual number of events to accomplish this varies year by year, which is the reason why "I" was used to signify the whole system. The program looks at all outfalls, catch basins, and grates and includes a visual inspection by personnel in the field. 100% of the system is done once per year.
