MS4 Permit Compliance

• LEGAL AUTHORITY: EACH PERMITTEE PASSED AN ORDINANCE WHICH PROHIBITS THE DISCHARGE OF ALMOST EVERYTHING BUT STORMWATER RUNOFF INTO ITS MS4.

- COMPLIANCE: AS PART OF THEIR IDDE PROGRAM, MOST PERMITTEES RELY ON PROPERLY TRAINED STAFF TO HELP REPORT ILLICIT DISCHARGES.
- TRAINING: TODAY'S TRAINING IS TO ENSURE YOU KNOW BOTH WHAT YOU ARE LOOKING FOR, <u>AND</u> REMIND YOU THAT YOU SHOULD KNOW HOW TO REPORT A SUSPECTED ILLICIT DISCHARGE IN YOUR MUNICIPALITY, COUNTY, OR AGENCY.



AN <u>ILLICIT DISCHARGE</u> IS ESSENTIALLY ANYTHING THAT IS INTRODUCED TO THE MS4 THAT IS NOT STORMWATER. IT MAY RESULT FROM:

- DELIBERATE DUMPING/DISPOSAL INTO THE MS4
- AN ACCIDENTAL SPILL/LEAK/DISCHARGE
- RUNOFF FROM A CONTAMINATED SITES OR CONSTRUCTION SITES
- A DELIBERATE (BUT UNPERMITTED) CONNECTION
 TO THE MS4



- CHEMICALS AND PETROLEUM
- NUTRIENTS AND FERTILIZER
- DETERGENTS AND WASHWATERS
- TRASH AND DUMPING
- SEWAGE
- SEDIMENTS
- CONCRETE WASHOUT



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


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


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3 SIMPLE STEPS:

- KEEP A KEEN EYE OUT FOR POSSIBLE ILLICIT DISCHARGES
- 2. TAKE PHOTOGRAPHS OF WHAT YOU OBSERVE
- 3. REPORT THE SUSPECTED ILLICIT OBSERVATION TO YOUR DESIGNATED HOTLINE <u>AND</u> TO YOUR IMMEDIATE SUPERVISOR.
 - DATE, TIME, AND SPECIFIC LOCATION



WHAT YOU DON'T NEED TO DO:

- CONFRONT A SUSPECTED OFFENDER
- COLLECT SAMPLES OR PHYSICAL EVIDENCE



SOME DISCHARGES ARE NOT ILLICIT/ILLEGAL:

- FLOWS FROM FIREFIGHTING
- WATER LINE FLUSHING OR OTHER CONTRIBUTIONS FROM POTABLE WATER SOURCES
- LANDSCAPE IRRIGATION AND LAWN WATERING
- IRRIGATION WATER
- DIVERTED STREAM FLOWS
- RISING GROUNDWATER
- DIRECT INFILTRATION OF GROUNDWATER TO THE SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEM
- UNCONTAMINATED PUMPED GROUNDWATER
- FOUNDATION AND FOOTING DRAINS
- WATER FROM CRAWL SPACE PUMPS
- UNCONTAMINATED AIR CONDITIONING CONDENSATION
- SPRINGS
- INDIVIDUAL RESIDENTIAL CAR WASHING
- FILTER BACKWASH FROM RESIDENTIAL SWIMMING POOLS
- FLOWS FROM RIPARIAN HABITATS AND WETLANDS



BEYOND REPORTING:

AFTER A SUSPECTED ILLICIT DISCHARGE IS FOUND OR REPORTED, EACH PERMITTEE HAS SOMEONE THAT CONDUCTS REACTIVE ACTIVITIES IN ORDER TO COMPLETE THE <u>ELIMINATION</u> PORTION OF IDDE:

- INVESTIGATION
- NOTIFICATION
- ELIMINATION
- ENFORCEMENT
