

# MS4 NPDES PERMIT

**BACKGROUND** 

- FEDERAL LAW REQUIRES THAT MUNICIPAL SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEMS (MS4S) THAT DISCHARGE TO WATERS OF THE STATE OR U.S., BE COVERED BY A NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT.
- BASED ON ITS POPULATION, PALM BEACH COUNTY WAS DESIGNATED A PHASE I MS4 PERMITTEE AND HAS TO COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE INDIVIDUAL MS4 PERMIT ISSUED BY THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION (FDEP).

## WHAT SHOULD I KNOW ABOUT SPILLS?



At your job, if you work with pollutants that can harm our water bodies, you should know how to do the following:

- Prevent a spill
- Recognize and quickly assess the nature of a spill
- Contain a spill
- Promptly report hazardous material and chemical spills to the appropriate authorities



MS4 Permit Compliance

#### AN SPCR PROGRAM REVIEW:

- PREVENT SPILLS, THROUGH PROPER STORAGE AND HOUSEKEEPING PRACTICES
- **CONTAIN** SPILLS WHEN THEY OCCUR TO MINIMIZE OR ELIMINATE ANY IMPACT TO THE MS4
- <u>RESPOND</u> TO SPILLS IN THE APPROPRIATE

  MANNER, WITH THE APPROPRIATE STAFF, USING

  THE APPROPRIATE MEASURES



#### **PREVENTION:**

- PROPER STORAGE (CONTAINER AND LOCATION)
  - APPROPRIATE CONTAINER
  - SAFE LOCATION (INSIDE OR COVERED)
  - CORRECT LABELING



- USE OF DRIP PANS AND/OR ABSORBENT PADS WHEN FILLING/DISPENSING
- PROPER DISPOSAL
- PROMPT STORAGE WHEN NOT IN USE

• ROUTINE EQUIPMENT INSPECTION & MAINTENANCE (TO PREVENT LEAKS)



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#### **CONTAINMENT:**

• SWIFT PLACEMENT OF BOOMS, INLET PROTECTION DEVICES, DAMS, DIVERSIONS, ETC. TO PREVENT THE SPILLED MATERIAL FROM ENTERING THE MS4, ANY NEARBY WATERWAY, OR FROM SATURATING THE GROUND.







#### **RESPONSE:**

- CONTACT YOUR
   DESIGNATED EMERGENCY
   RESPONSE COORDINATOR.
- ONLY CLEAN-UP SPILLS IF YOU KNOW WHAT THE MATERIAL IS, AND YOU'VE HAD PROPER TRAINING.






### **KEY NOTE: PREPARATION!**

- KNOW HOW TO CONTACT YOUR DESIGNATED EMERGENCY RESPONSE COORDINATOR
- BE FAMILIAR WITH YOUR MUNICIPAL, COUNTY, AGENCY, OR DEPARTMENT SPCR
- KNOW THE LOCATION OF ALL SPILL KITS AND/OR SPILL LOCKERS IN THE AREAS WHERE YOU WORK
- KNOW HOW TO USE THE SPILL KIT












#### SOME OF THE MOST COMMON FORMS OF ILLICIT DISCHARGE:

- CHEMICALS
- PETROLEUM
- FERTILIZER
- DETERGENTS AND WASH WATERS
- TRASH AND DUMPING
- SEWAGE
- SEDIMENTS, LAWN DEBRIS, & PET WASTE
- CONCRETE WASHOUT





















MS4 Permit Compliance

- LEGAL AUTHORITY: EACH PERMITTEE PASSED AN ORDINANCE WHICH PROHIBITS THE DISCHARGE OF ALMOST EVERYTHING BUT STORMWATER RUNOFF INTO ITS MS4.
- COMPLIANCE: AS PART OF THEIR IDDE PROGRAM, MOST PERMITTEES RELY ON PROPERLY TRAINED STAFF TO HELP REPORT ILLICIT DISCHARGES.
- TRAINING: TODAY'S TRAINING IS TO ENSURE YOU KNOW BOTH WHAT YOU ARE LOOKING FOR, <u>AND</u> REMIND YOU THAT YOU SHOULD KNOW HOW TO REPORT A SUSPECTED ILLICIT DISCHARGE IN YOUR MUNICIPALITY, COUNTY, OR AGENCY.



### 3 SIMPLE STEPS:

- 1. KEEP A KEEN EYE OUT FOR POSSIBLE ILLICIT DISCHARGES
- 2. TAKE PHOTOGRAPHS OF WHAT YOU OBSERVE
- 3. REPORT THE SUSPECTED ILLICIT OBSERVATION TO YOUR DESIGNATED HOTLINE AND TO YOUR IMMEDIATE SUPERVISOR.
  - DATE, TIME, AND SPECIFIC LOCATION



### **BEYOND REPORTING:**

AFTER A SUSPECTED ILLICIT DISCHARGE IS FOUND OR REPORTED, EACH PERMITTEE HAS SOMEONE THAT CONDUCTS REACTIVE ACTIVITIES IN ORDER TO COMPLETE THE <u>ELIMINATION</u> PORTION OF IDDE:

- INVESTIGATION
- NOTIFICATION
- ELIMINATION
- ENFORCEMENT





# CONSTRUCTION SITE EROSION & SEDIMENTATION CONTROL

#### **MS4 PERMIT REQUIREMENTS:**

- PERMITTEE CONSTRUCTION SITE PLAN REVIEWERS (SPRS),
   CONSTRUCTION SITE OPERATORS (CSO), AND CONSTRUCTION SITE
   INSPECTORS (CSI) ARE <u>REQUIRED</u> TO HAVE ANNUAL (REFRESHER)
   TRAINING ON CONSTRUCTION SITE EROSION AND SEDIMENTATION
   CONTROL PRACTICES.
- PERMITTEE CSI MUST BE <u>CERTIFIED</u> THROUGH THE STATE'S STORMWATER, EROSION, AND SEDIMENTATION CONTROL COURSE. (NEXT PALM BEACH COUNTY COURSE IS: MAY 12, & 13, 2020)
- PRIVATE CONSTRUCTION SITE OPERATORS THAT WORK WITHIN PERMITTEE'S MS4 AREA, MUST ALSO BE TRAINED. \*

\* SOME PERMITTEES HAVE INDICATED THAT THEY MEET THIS REQUIREMENT DURING THE PRE-CONSTRUCTION MEETINGS HELD PRIOR TO THE START OF ANY CONSTRUCTION PROJECT THEY PERMIT.
