**VENDOR(S):** WETLANDS MANAGEMENT SF, LLC

**BACKGROUND:** The aquatic vegetation and exotic species management service is necessary for the free flow of water, the control of exotic species, and the maintenance of aesthetics. The work involves chemical/pesticide application, biological treatment, or mechanical removal of aquatic weeds throughout the specified bodies of water, including canals, waterways, and the wetlands and preserve areas of the City's golf course. The current agreement will expire in April, and the Public Services Department wishes to exercise the available option to renew the Agreement for another two years.

**COMMENTS:** This Amendment will renew the Agreement for an additional two years. The initial agreement term was for three years, and the City has no outstanding vendor performance issues with the company. Wetlands Management SF, LLC is a well-established firm that has contracts with several private and public entities to perform aquatic vegetation and exotic species management services. The monthly pricing established three years ago is the same applicable rate for the new two-year agreement term.

**AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO AGREEMENT  
FOR  
AQUATIC VEGETATION AND EXOTIC SPECIES MANAGEMENT**

**AGREEMENT NO. ITB2014-041PF**

THIS AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE AGREEMENT is made and entered into this \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2018 (the "effective date") by and between the **City of Palm Beach Gardens**, a Florida municipal corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "City"), whose address is 10500 North Military Trail, Palm Beach Gardens, Florida 33410, and **Wetlands Management SF, LLC**, a Florida corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor"), whose mailing address is 4696 SW Leighton Farm Avenue, Palm City, Florida 34990.

WHEREAS, the City executed an Agreement on April 2, 2015, with the Contractor under Invitation to Bid No. ITB2014-041PF, Aquatic Vegetation and Exotic Species Management; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement expires on April 30, 2018, with the option to renew for an additional two years; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Contractor have mutually agreed to renew the Agreement for an additional two years.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises hereafter set forth, the Contractor and the City agree as follows:

1. The Agreement is renewed for an additional two years effective May 1, 2018, and shall expire April 30, 2020.
2. All terms, covenants, and conditions of the Agreement and any addenda, modifications, or amendments thereto shall remain in full force and effect, except to the extent herein amended.
3. The City's estimated expenditure under this Agreement, inclusive of all projects under the Agreement, shall be Seventy-Three Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-Four Dollars (\$73,824).




